NOTICE OF NO OBJECTION TO LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY  
GOVERNEMENT'S EMERGENCY MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL  
SCHEDULE

The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention, files this notice of no objection to Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's (LFUCG) Emergency Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule. In response, the Attorney General states the following.

By order dated December 21, 2008, the Commission requested all of the parties to address certain questions. With regard to the LFUCG, the Commission specifically noted that the LFUCG had not formally adopted a position and stated that "its silence is perplexing."<sup>1</sup> Presumably, the LFUCG asks for additional time in which to arrive at a position. Accordingly, the Attorney General does not object to the motion but asks that a final date certain be established.

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
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
