Re: Open Records Request

Dear Sir or Madam:

Pursuant to Kentucky's Open Records Act, KRS 61.870 et seq, the Public Service Commission requests the following documents:

- 1. All documents related to any negotiations between Kentucky-American Water Company ("KAWC") and Louisville Water Company ("LWC") since January 1, 1994, regarding KAWC's purchase of water or water-related services from LWC.
- 2. All documents (including studies, analyses, and reports) that have been prepared or commissioned since January 1, 1994 and that address the cost, whether known or estimated, to LWC of providing water or water-related services to KAWC.
- 3. All documents (including studies, analyses, and reports) that have been prepared or commissioned since January 1, 1994 and that address the cost, whether known or estimated, to KAWC of LWC providing water or water-related services to KAWC.
- 4. All documents related to or arising from any proposals, plans, discussions, or negotiations on or after January 1, 2005 to extend LWC's wholesale or retail service or sale of water beyond LWC's present operations.
- 5. All studies, analyses, and reports, internal memoranda, and correspondence that address LWC's present customer demand.
- 6. All studies, analyses, and reports, internal memoranda, and correspondence that address LWC's projected customer demand.



- 7. All studies, analyses, and reports, internal memoranda and correspondence that address the present capacity of LWC's existing water treatment and transmission facilities.
- 8. All documents (including studies, analyses, and reports) that discuss the planned or potential expansion of LWC's water treatment and transmission capacity for the next 15 years.
- 9. All documents related to any negotiations, discussions, or agreements in which LWC has engaged or entered since January 1, 1994, to furnish wholesale or retail water or water-related services to a municipal or public utility or to any public entity that provides or intends to provide water service directly to the public or to public water suppliers.

For any requested public record of which you do not have custody or control, the Public Service Commission requests the name and location of the agency in possession of that record and the name of the official custodian of its public records. Unless otherwise stated, all requests for "documents" should be considered to include all "public records" as that term is defined in KRS 61.870(2).
