I support Kentucky American Water's proposed water supply solution and encourage you to grant approval. As a resident of rural, Jessamine County not far from the Fayette County line, I hope to benefit from this project through the collaborative efforts of BWSC and KAW. I became aware of the need to improve our water supply system when providing communication consulting services to the City of Nicholasville several years ago and learned that we would have a very limited supply of water on hand should our one source be curtailed for some reason. I later became well versed in the details of this plan as I assisted Kentucky American Water with its communications.

The region's drought is still evident on my farm as our spring is completely dry. My small cattle farm and the large horse farm next door where valuable thoroughbreds are bred and raised are depending upon a prompt, comprehensive water supply solution for their future viability. I believe the plan before you is the best way to go.
