To Whom It May Concern:

I am the landowner of 4586 Iron Works Rd. I worked hard to purchase the land and build my home. Among the many reasons I chose to build in the Iron Works area was the beautiful trees, the historical horse farms and the pride and determination of the homeowners who keep their land and the area in excellent condition. Vowing never to let anything invade what I have worked very hard for, I became one of these prideful and determined landowners in 2000.


I am highly opposed to "Kentucky American's plan to construct a water treatment plant at Pool 3 in Owen County and the 30 mile pipeline that would connect this treatment plant to Kentucky American Water Company's water system in Fayette County."

I will not give up my land. I will not allow them to have a 30-foot-wide permanent easement for the pipeline with an additional 30 feet on either side for construction. "The easements for the pipeline will permanently restrict land use along the route." Giving Kentucky American Water this permanent easement will allow them to consume my entire front yard. I am appalled!

"The residents in the communities along the pipeline route would bear most of the burden of this project, including disruptions during construction and numerous environmental and community impacts, but would receive few, if any, benefits." This is unethical, unjust, and utterly unfair to those of us who labor everyday to ensure our families have a beautiful, peaceful, and geographically welcoming residence.

As a concerned resident, I am asking the Public Service Commission to keep the pipeline out of the Elkhorn Creek Valley and Iron Works Pike area and support the proposal from Louisville.
