We are legal counsel to North Central Telephone Cooperative Corporation ("North Central"). In that capacity, we have been requested to formally advise you that North Central hereby voluntarily delays the effective date of the proposed changes to its basic residential and business rates as reflected in North Central's Local Exchange Tariff, PSC Kentucky Tariff No. 3, filed as Exhibit 1 to North Central's application for adjustment of rates filed with the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (the "Commission") on October 11, 2007.

In recognition of the fact that North Central filed a letter with the Commission today converting North Central's rate application from one supported by a fully-forecasted test period to one supported by a historical test period, North Central wishes to provide the Commission with additional time to evaluate North Central's rate application prior to the effective date of the revised tariff.

Presently, the revised tariff becomes effective Monday, November 12, 2007. By way of this letter, North Central voluntarily delays the effective date of the revised tariff to Monday, November 26, 2007. North Central is hopeful that this delay will provide the Commission with sufficient time to evaluate North Central's rate application prior to the new basic residential and business rates taking effect.
