



Kenergy Corp. ("Kenergy") hereby provides notice that it will file, within the next 30 days, an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission seeking to amend its Rate Schedule 41 (Large Industrial Customers Served Under Special Contract for All Load Subject to the Big Rivers Large Industrial Customer Expansion Rate).

Under the amendments to the rate schedule, Kenergy will offer real time pricing to its large industrial customers with loads subject to service under terms and conditions set forth in the Large Industrial Customer Expansion Rate of Big Rivers Electric Corporation. The rate for real time pricing purchases under the amended rate schedule will be a Special Contract Rate negotiated with Kenergy based on market pricing scheduled a day or week ahead. 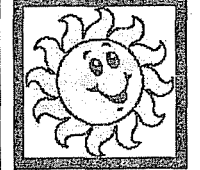

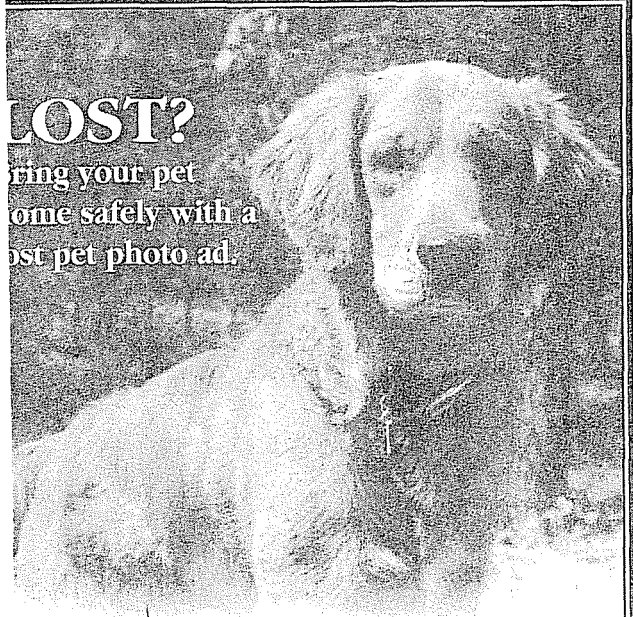

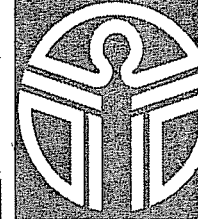
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
