

Dear Beth:

In its Order issued on May 25, 2007, in the above-referenced case, the Commission requested that parties to the arbitration file any requests for formal hearing in this matter by June 8. As stated in its arbitration Petition filed on May 7 (at paragraph 22), Sprint does not anticipate any need for the Commission to reach a determination on disputed facts in connection with the legal issue presented in Sprint's Petition. Accordingly, a formal hearing does not appear to be necessary. However, Sprint believes that oral argument by counsel regarding the legal issues in this case would be beneficial and would provide the Commission a complete record on which to base its determinations in this matter. Should the Commission believe that a full evidentiary hearing would also be beneficial, Sprint would not object and would most willingly participate in such a hearing.
