

This matter having come before the Commission for hearing pursuant to the Motion of the Complainant Carroll County Water District No. 1, the parties having agreed, said agreement having been mechanically, and the Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. During the pendency of this proceeding, the Defendant Gallatin County Water District shall not construct any water lines within the territory of the Complainant Carroll County Water District No. 1, and shall not allow a third party to connect to its existing water line within the territory of the Complainant Carroll County Water District No. 1; and,

2. During the pendency of this proceeding, the Defendant Gallatin County Water District shall not furnish water or sell water from its existing water line within the territory of the Complainant Carroll County Water District No. 1. Provided, however, said District may continue to sell water from its existing water lines to customers served thereby as of July 18, 2007.




