REQUEST 1. Refer to the response to the Commission Staff's Second Data Request dated September 28, 2007 ("Staff Second Request"), Item 1.

REQUEST 1a. The proposed tariff does not include provisions for rebates if existing furnaces are replaced with new, high efficient heat pumps for manufactured homes. Explain in detail how the replacement of furnaces in existing manufactured homes can qualify for a rebate under the terms of the proposed tariff.

RESPONSE 1a. EKPC is amending the proposed tariff by adding the following sentence: "For customers with inefficient electric heating systems, EKPC will rebate \$150 for replacing their existing furnace with a heat pump that meets minimum Energy Star Standards." Page 1 of the Attachment to this request incorporates this sentence into the tariff sheet. Page 2 of the Attachment is the redline version of the tariff changes. Additionally, EKPC is also amending the proposed tariff to reflect a fixed payment of \$250 for each new certified manufactured home.

REQUEST 1b. Provide the SEER for the new highly efficient heat pump that will be replacing the inefficient existing furnace.

Touchstone Energy Manufactured Home Program

Purpose

The Touchstone Energy Manufactured Home Program is a conservation program that encourages the sale of more energy-efficient manufactured homes. It is based on the *Energy Star* standards for manufactured homes, a nationally recognized symbol of energy efficiency and quality developed and operated jointly by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE).

Availability

This program is available in all service territory served by EKPC.

Eligibility

To qualify as a Touchstone Energy Manufactured Home under EKPC's program, the participating manufactured home must be located in the service territory of a participating Member System and meet the *Energy Star* standards by including additional floor, wall and ceiling insulation, double pane windows and an electric heat pump.

Rebate

EKPC will provide an incentive for retail customers of our Member Systems to participate in this program by offering a one-time rebate. EKPC will rebate \$250 per certified manufactured home to the participating Member System. Rebates will be paid to the participating Member Systems upon written certification that the retail participant has met the *Energy Star* standards for newly constructed manufactured homes.

For customers who purchase a manufactured home which only includes a heat pump meeting Energy Star standards, EKPC will rebate \$150. For customers with inefficient electric heating systems, EKPC will rebate \$150 for replacing their existing furnace with a heat pump that meets minimum Energy Star Standards.

Annual Reports

EKPC will submit annual reports on the Program that contain the number of participants from each Member System, the annual costs, including the costs of the rebates, and the status of the rebate provision. EKPC will file the first report by March 31, 2004, and annually thereafter.

REQUEST 5. Pursuant to the Touchstone Energy Manufactured Home Tariff the Commission approved in Case No. 2002-003131, EKPC was required to rebate \$250 per certified manufactured home to the member system.

REQUEST 5a. Explain why the rebates paid by EKPC in 2003-2006, as shown in the response to Item 4 of Staff's Second Request, were not \$250 as stated in the tariff.

RESPONSE 5a. During that period, EKPC matched the rebate offered by the Member System. The total rebate would be at least \$250, but EKPC's portion was one-half of the total.

REQUEST 5b. State who determined the amount of the rebates that were paid in 2003-2006.

RESPONSE 5b. The Member System determined the total amount of the rebate to the customer. Under the Partner's Plus Marketing Program, EKPC matched the rebate

amount offered by the Member System. This resulted in a rebate to the customer of at least \$250. In no instance did EKPC provide a rebate of more than \$250. However, EKPC did not provide a \$250 blanket amount for each customer.

REQUEST 5c. Explain the criteria used to determine the amount of the rebates that were paid in 2003-2006.

RESPONSE 5c. The Member System made the determination of the total amount of the rebate for each customer.
