COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND DATA REQUEST TO EAST KENTUCKY POWER COOPERATIVE, INC.

East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC") is requested, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, to file with the Commission the original and seven copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due within 10 days of the date of this request. Each copy of the data requested should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6, and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation, a partnership, an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

EKPC shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information upon the basis of which it knows that the response was incorrect when made, or though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any

request to which EKPC fails to furnish all or part of the requested information, EKPC shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to furnish.

Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure its legibility. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request.

If EKPC will be rebating \$250 per participant to the member system for the member system to flow this rebate through to the participant, explain in detail how this strategy will help achieve the increased participants projected on page 3 of 9.
- 2. Refer to the Response to Commission Staff's First Data Request dated August 27, 2007, Item 1, page 3 of 9. Provide the methodology and sources of information that support the growth in manufactured homes for years 1 through 5 for new customers of 70, 130, 180, 240, and 300.
- 3. Identify the member systems participating in this program. By the name of each participating member system include the number of customers that have participated in the program for each year since the program began.
- 4. Provide an accounting of EKPC's payments to each participating member system related to participation in this program for each year since the program began.
