- Q-1. Refer to LG&E's Attachment to Question No. 6 of LG&E's Response to Information Requested in Appendix A of the Commission's Order dated August 3, 2007, page 4 of 15. Please explain how the shortfall of deliveries in 2005 and 2006 are being made up by the vendor.
- A-1. The shortfall tonnage from Charolais Coal Contract LGE05011 was incorporated into a new Contract with Charolais Coal J07003 (refer to LG&E's Attachment to Question No. 6 of LG&E's Response to Information Requested in Appendix A of the Commission's Order dated August 3, 2007, page 5 of 15). The shortfall tonnage under Contract LGE05011 was approximately 600,000 tons, which was spread at the rate of 200,000 tons per year over a three year period. The averaging of the old Contract LGE05011 and new Contract J07003 is outlined below:
