ORDER

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of regional meetings held in July 2007 in Whitesville, Kentucky; Morehead, Kentucky; and Draffenville, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties." The programs for which approval is sought include instruction on hydrants and their maintenance, the uses, applications, and maintenance of pumps and motors. Having reviewed KRWA's application describing the proposed courses, the Commission finds that the programs will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties and should be approved for 2.0 credit hours for commissioner and board member training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. KRWA's proposed courses of instruction are hereby approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours.
- 2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved courses of instruction.
- 3. Within 14 days of the date of this Order, KRWA shall file with the Commission a sworn statement attesting that the approved courses of instruction were performed and, if any changes in the speakers or course curriculum occurred after KRWA's application, a description of those changes.
