## ORDER

On July 19, 2007, Green Hills Water District ("Green Hills") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Green Hills purchases water from the Pineville Utility Commission ("Pineville").
2. Pineville notified Green Hills that, effective with its June 1, 2007 billing, Pineville's wholesale water rate to Green Hills would increase from $\$ 1.75$ per 1,000 gallons to $\$ 1.87$ per 1,000 gallons. Green Hills proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective August 25, 2007.
3. Green Hills proposed a purchased water adjustment factor of $\$ 0.19$ per 1,000 gallons. Due to a rounding error Green Hills miscalculated the purchased water adjustment factor.
4. During the 12 months ended April 30, 2007, Green Hills purchased a total of $31,511,180$ gallons of water and sold $19,227,460$ gallons. The increase in the cost of
purchased water is $\$ 3,781.34$, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of $\$ 0.20$ per 1,000 gallons.
5. The purchased water adjustment factor of $\$ 0.20$ per 1,000 gallons is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Green Hills Water District are denied.
2. The purchased water adjustment factor of $\$ 0.20$ per 1,000 gallons as calculated in Appendix $A$ is approved.
3. The rates in Appendix $B$ attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved for services rendered on and after August 25, 2007.
4. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Green Hills shall file with the Commission revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
