MOTION OF LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY AND KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY FOR LEAVE TO FILE RESPONSIVE COMMENTS AND TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") and Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") (collectively, the "Companies") hereby move the Public Service Commission ("Commission") for leave to file comments in response to the intervenors' comments, if any, and to modify the procedural schedule of this proceeding accordingly. In support of this Motion, the Companies state that the ability to respond to any proposed modifications to the Demand-Side Management programs under review will likely obviate the need for a hearing in this proceeding. To allow adequate time to prepare their responsive comments, the Companies propose to submit their responsive comments to the Commission seven days after the deadline for the intervenors' comments. The current procedural schedule, set out in the Commission's October 12, 2007 Order in this proceeding, requires intervenors to submit their comments by October 26th, which, if the Commission grants the Companies' Motion, would require the Companies to submit their comments by November 2nd. WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully move the Commission (1) to grant them leave to file responsive comments seven days after the deadline for intervenors' comments and (2) to modify the procedural schedule of this proceeding accordingly.
