I have been asked by Mr. Lloyd Creech to send correspondence to you regarding the application of Shared Sites, LLC and American Cellular Corporation to construct and operate a new facility to provide wireless communications at McCormick Road, Camargo, Kentucky. Mr. Creech has recently purchased the property originally owned by TSK Partners, LLC. Your office sent a notice to TSK Partners, LLC inviting comments regarding the proposed construction and TSK Partners; LLC provided the notice to Mr. Creech.

Mr. Creech would like to inform you that he does have concerns regarding the construction of the new facility. Once he received the notice, he went to his property and observed that the area where the proposed facility is to be located is approximately twenty to twenty-five feet from his property line. Due to the close proximity to his property he has concerns about possible damage to his property should the tower undergo damage and it or pieces of the tower land on his property. Further, he believes that the close proximity of the facility to his property will diminish the value of his property. Finally, Mr. Creech has concerns about health aspects of the community. He feels that the community may be at risk of health problems if a cell tower were to be built in the area.
