Dear Ms. Haney:

Due to a rate increase from the City of Morehead, please accept this as formal notice that the Bath County Water District has filed an Application for a Purchased Water Adjustment with the Public Service Commission for the purpose of adjusting its water rates. The new wholesale rate will increase by .13 cents per 1,000 gallons purchased. This proposed change will be effective for all bills issued on and after August 15, 2007.

The rate in this notice is the rate proposed by the Bath County Water District. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from this rate. Such action may result in rates other than the rate included in this notice.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CARLISLE, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1: That Section § 51.42 of the Code of Ordinances is amended as follows:

(A) Section § 51.42 Water Rates. All water customers of the City of Carlisle beginning with the bills due July, 2000 shall pay the following rates for water:

Industrial Rate	1.00 <del>1.00</del>	1.50 <del>1.30</del>	Per 1,000 gallons

The rate for all water hauled from the water plant is \$6.25 ~~5.50~~ per 1,000 gallons.

(B) All water customers shall pay a minimum charge per month in an amount equal to the rate for the first 1,000 gallons or less as set out above, and the City Clerk/Treasurer shall so bill the customers.

(C) Industrial Rate: Any Industrial water customer using in excess of an average of five million gallons (5MG) of water per month each month for the previous twelve (12) month period shall qualify for the Industrial rate. There will also be a payment of a monthly service charge of \$250.00 Industrial Rate Customers.
