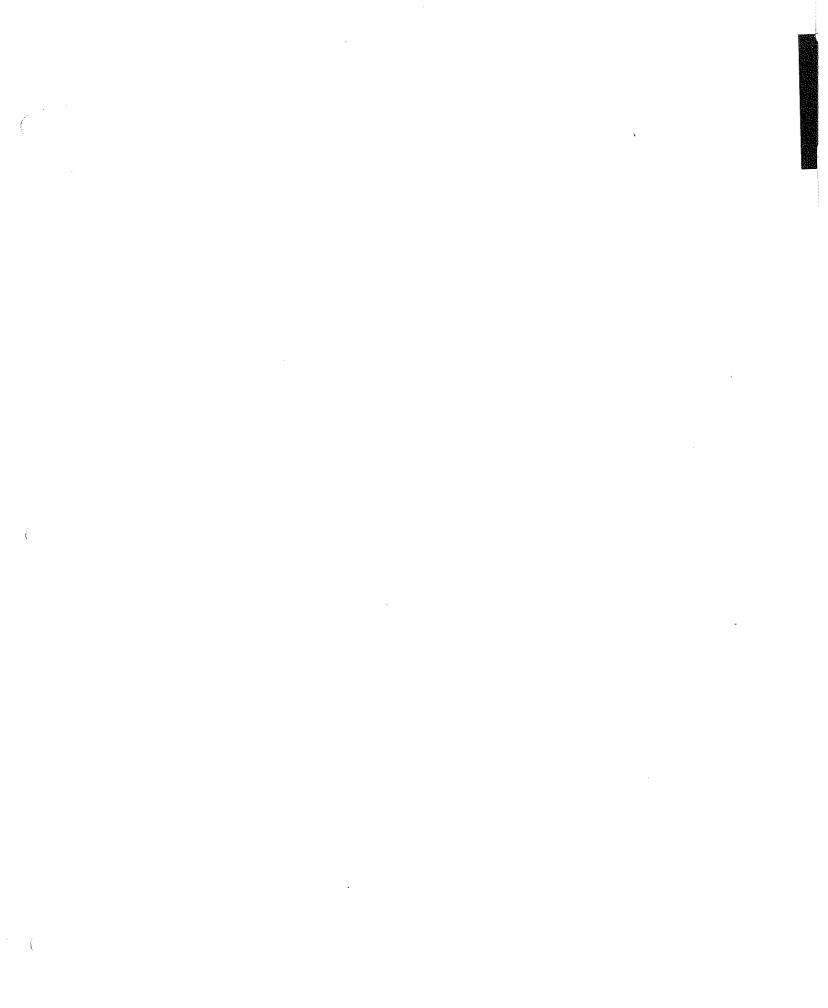

The District plans to implement the proposed rates upon approval by the PSC.

THE APPLICATION OF WESTERN FLEMING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT FOR A GENERAL RATE ADJUSTMENT, TO INCREASE NON-RECURRING CHARGES AND TO REVISE ITS TARIFF PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF KRS 278.030, 278.0152, 807 KAR 5:001 AND 807 5:011

CASE NO. 2007-HISTORICAL TEST YEAR UTILIZED

PETITION

The Applicant, WESTERN FLEMING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT ("Western Fleming"), acting by and through its Board of Commissioners, respectfully tenders this Petition and Application, pursuant to KRS 278.030, KRS 278.0152, 807 KAR 5:001, 807 KAR 5:011, and all other applicable laws and regulations, and request that the Public Service Commission of Kentucky)the "PSC") enter an Order (1) approving the proposed adjustment of water rates and charges to be levied and collected by Western Fleming; (2) approving the proposed adjustment to its non-recurring charges; (3) approving the proposed adjustment to its tap fees. In support of this Petition and Application, and in conformity with the rules of the PSC, Western Fleming states as follows:

1. Western Fleming requests the PSC take the following actions:

To approve the proposed adjustment of water rates and charges to all customers, with the exception of two wholesale rates. The proposed rate adjustment should produce approximately \$986,507 in additional revenues. This is an increase of approximately \$379,682 or 65% over adjusted test year water sales revenue.

To approve the proposed adjustment to Western Fleming's special, non-recurring charges;

To approve the proposed adjustment to Western Fleming's meter connection charge.

 Western Fleming plans to implement the proposed water service rates, non-recurring charges, meter connection (tap) fees and the revised tariff sheets upon Commission approval.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 3. Western Fleming is a public body corporate. It has the power to make contracts in furtherance of its lawful and proper purposes as provided in KRS 74.070 and all other applicable laws.
- 4. The mailing address of Western Fleming is as follows:

- 5. Western Fleming is engaged in the business of providing an adequate supply of potable water for domestic, agricultural, commercial and wholesale use to a large portion of Fleming County.
- Western Fleming provides water service to approximately 1,361 retail customers and three wholesale customers; (1) Buffalo Trail Water Association; (2) Maysville Utilities – Southern Madision and (3) Nicholas County Water District.

REASONS FOR RATE INCREASE

- During the past few years Western Fleming's financial condition has deteriorated because of operating losses. The losses were caused because of increased operating and maintenance expenses.
- 8. A rate adjustment to the water service rates will be necessary:

A. To meet the increased costs of operations;

B. To enable Western Fleming to pay its annual principal and interest payments on its existing long term debts from water revenues.

- C. To enable Western Fleming to meet the coverage requirements (120%) set forth in its existing debt instruments;
- D. To restore Western Fleming's to a sound financial condition;

- E. To enable Western Fleming to enhance its financial capacity so it can continue to operate its system in compliance with the federal Safe Drinking Water Act, as amended and KRS Chapter 151; and
- F. To enable Western Fleming to continue to provide adequate service.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

9. During the past few years Western Fleming's financial condition has deteriorated because of operating losses. The losses were caused because of increased operating and maintenance expenses.

10. It is hereby certified that Western Fleming's annual reports, including the annual report for the test year, are on file with the PSC in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 3(1), and the annual report for 2006 is attached for the Commission's convenience as Exhibit 1.

11. The provisions of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(1)(b)(3) through 10(1)(b)(5) are not applicable because Western Fleming is neither a corporation nor a limited partnership.

12. Western Fleming does not operate under an assumed name. Consequently, the filing of an assumed name certificate, as required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(1)(b)(6), is not necessary.

RATE ADJUSTMENT

- 13. For the reasons stated in paragraphs 8 and 9, a rate adjustment that will generate approximately \$379,682 in additional water sale revenues will be necessary. This represents an increase of approximately 65% over adjustment test year water revenues.
- 14. Western Fleming understands that it could make adjustments to Test Year income and expenses for any known and measurable changes that have occurred since the end of the test year but does not want to implement rates higher than those proposed herein.

15. Rather than increase all usage blocks by a uniform percentage to generate the required revenue, Western Fleming has prepared a comprehensive Cost of Service Study, which is appended hereto as Exhibit 8.

- 15. Western Fleming proposes to use the twelve consecutive months ending December 31, 2006 as the test year.
- 16. Exhibit 4, Revenue Requirements, shows that Western Fleming needs to increase its revenues by \$379,682. This means Western Fleming needs to generate revenues of approximately \$966,507 from the proposed water service rates and charges.
- 17. Exhibit 7 sets forth the revenues currently generated by the residential and wholesale customers. Exhibit 10, sets forth the revenue to be

generated based on the proposed rates. The revised tariff is set forth in Exhibit 12.

- 18. Adjusting the rates as set forth in accordance with the rate study will generate revenues of approximately \$966,507.
- 19. Exhibit 10, Verification of Proposed Rates, demonstrates that the proposed rates will generate the required revenues.
- 20. A schedule of current rates in effect and the proposed rates is set forth in comparative form in Exhibit 2. The dollar amount of increase and the percentage of increase for each usage block and meter size are also shown in this exhibit.
- 21. The effect of the proposed rate adjustment on the average customer's bill is shown in Exhibit 2.
- 22. Western Fleming's proposed tariff sheets in a form which complies with 807 KAR 5:011 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(1)(b)(7), is appended hereto as Exhibit 3.
- 23. Western Fleming's present and proposed tariff, in a comparative form which complies with 807 KAR 5:011 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(1)(b)(8) is appended hereto as Exhibit 2.

24. Western Fleming has published and posted the required customer notice in compliance with subsections (3) and (4) of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10 and 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8. A copy of the public notice of proposed adjustment of water rates is appended hereto as Exhibit 5. The notice will be published in accordance with PSC regulations for three consecutive weeks. Newspaper tear sheets and the publishers Affidavit evidencing publication in the newspaper will be forwarded to the PSC as soon as they have been received.

- 25. Western Fleming does not plan to support the application with prepared testimony. It respectfully the PSC staff to perform a field review if necessary of Western Fleming's financial records and issue a staff report just as the staff routinely does in general rate cases filed by water districts.
- 26. Western Fleming is not a local exchange company within the meaning of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(6)(f).
- 27. The billing analysis required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(6)(g) is appended as Exhibit 10.
- 28. The independent auditor's annual opinion report required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(6)(k) for the calendar year ending December 31, 2005 is appended hereto as Exhibit 6. The audit report for the year ending December 31, 2006 will be filed as soon as it is completed by the auditor.
- 29. The list of computer software used in developing the schedules and work papers associated with the filing of Western Fleming's application is Microsoft Word and Excel.
- 30. The monthly managerial reports as required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(6)r are appended hereto as Exhibit 3.

- 31. Fleming County is not proposing a capital construction at this time and no budget is filed as otherwise required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(7)(b).
- 32. Furthermore, Western Fleming states that it has not adopted a capital construction budget concerning any future additions or improvements to its plant.
- 33. In the alternative, Western Fleming moves for a deviation from or a waiver of, the requirement that it file its most recent capital construction budget as required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(7)(b). No such capital improvement construction budget exists. Western Fleming like most smaller water districts and associations, does not normally provide for or maintain a capital improvement construction budget. Any new construction occurs on a case-by-case project basis. This motion for a deviation, or a request for waiver, is being filed pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14.
- 34. The proposed rates are fair, just and reasonable and are necessary for Western Fleming (a) to continue providing adequate, reliable service to its customers; (b) to enable Western Fleming to pay its annual principal payments on its existing long term debts from water revenues rather than from reserves; (c) to enable Western Fleming to meet the coverage requirements set forth in its existing debt instruments; (d) to restore Western Fleming to a sound financial condition and (e) to enable Western Fleming to operate its system in

compliance with the federal Safe Drinking Act, as amended, and KRS Chapter 151.

NON-RECURRING CHARGES

- 35. The proposed amount of each non-recurring charge is also set forth on Exhibit No. 3, the proposed Tariff.
- 36. Specific cost justification worksheets for the proposed non-recurring charges are appended as Exhibit 11.
- 37. The proposed charges are equal to the expenses incurred by Western Fleming in providing the associated service. Hence, implementation of the proposed non-recurring charge will be revenue neutral.
- 38. Western Fleming is currently losing money each time it performs any of these services.
- 39. The only customers that will be impacted by these non-recurring charges will be the customers who request the services or whose actions require the District to incur the associated expense.
- 40. Western Fleming proposes to implement the charges at the same time the increased rates become effective.

MISCELLANEOUS

41. In order to comply with all applicable rules and regulations of the PSC, all Exhibits contained in the Exhibit Addendum attached hereto are incorporated herein by reference.

- 42.A copy of this Petition and Application, together with all exhibits, has been delivered to the Office of Rate Intervention of the Office of the Attorney General as required by 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10(1)(b).
- 43. A Filing Requirement Index, which shows the location of all documents required by the applicable administrative regulations, or explains the reason for the absence of any documents, is included with the Application.

WHEREFORE, Western Fleming respectfully requests that the PSC take the following actions:

- A. Approve the proposed adjustment of water rates and charges to all customers;
- B. Approve the proposed adjustment to Western Fleming's non-recurring charges;
- C. Approve the proposed increase to Western Fleming's meter connection (tap) fees;
- D. Approve Western Fleming's revised tariff sheets
- E. Grant Western Fleming a deviation or waiver from the requirement that it file a capital improvement budget as required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(7)(b).
- F. Grant Western Fleming any and all other proper relief

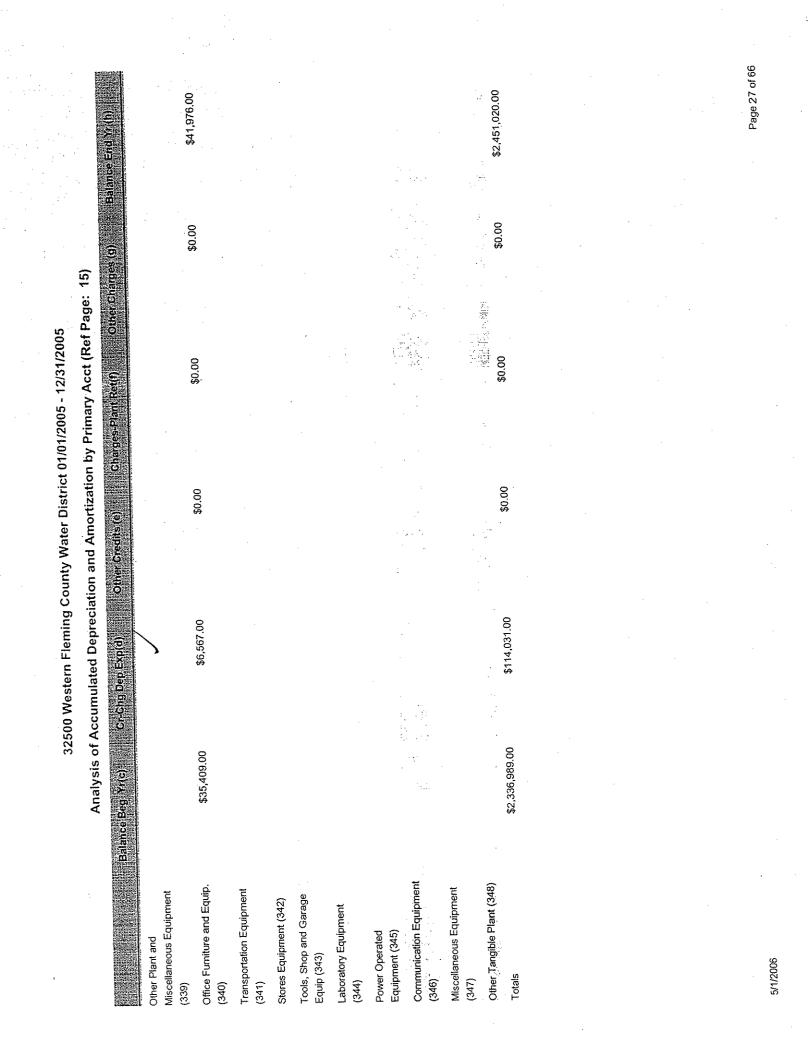

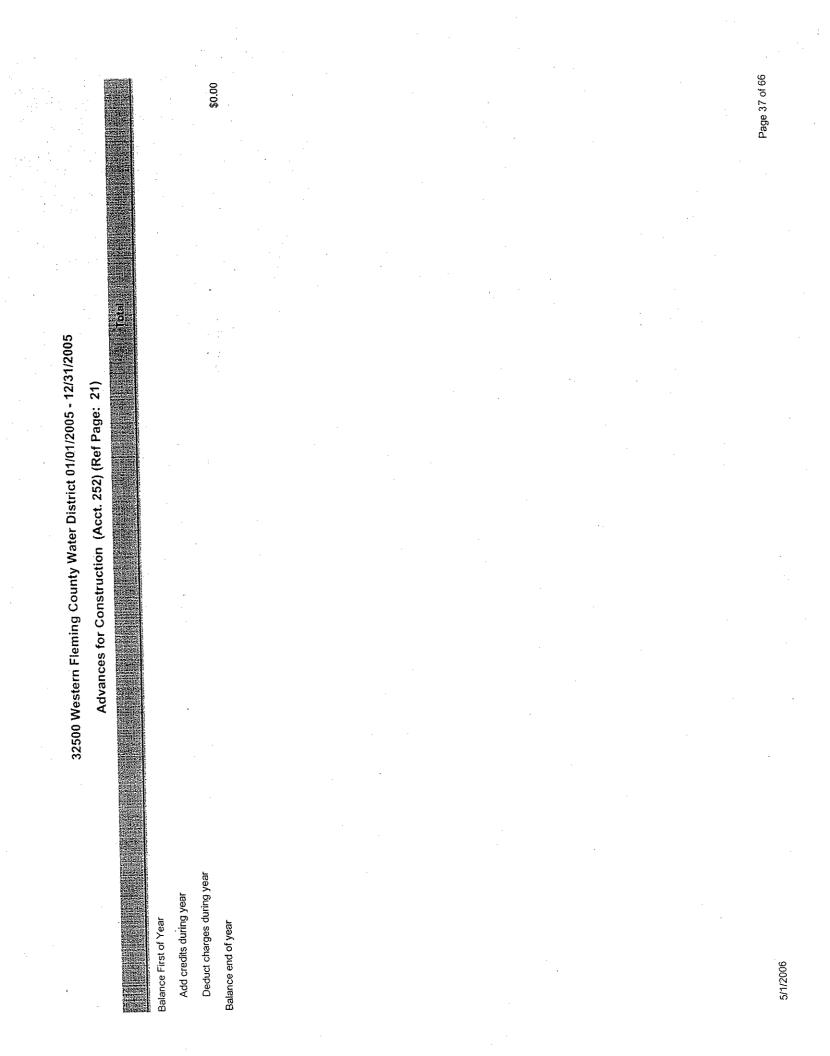

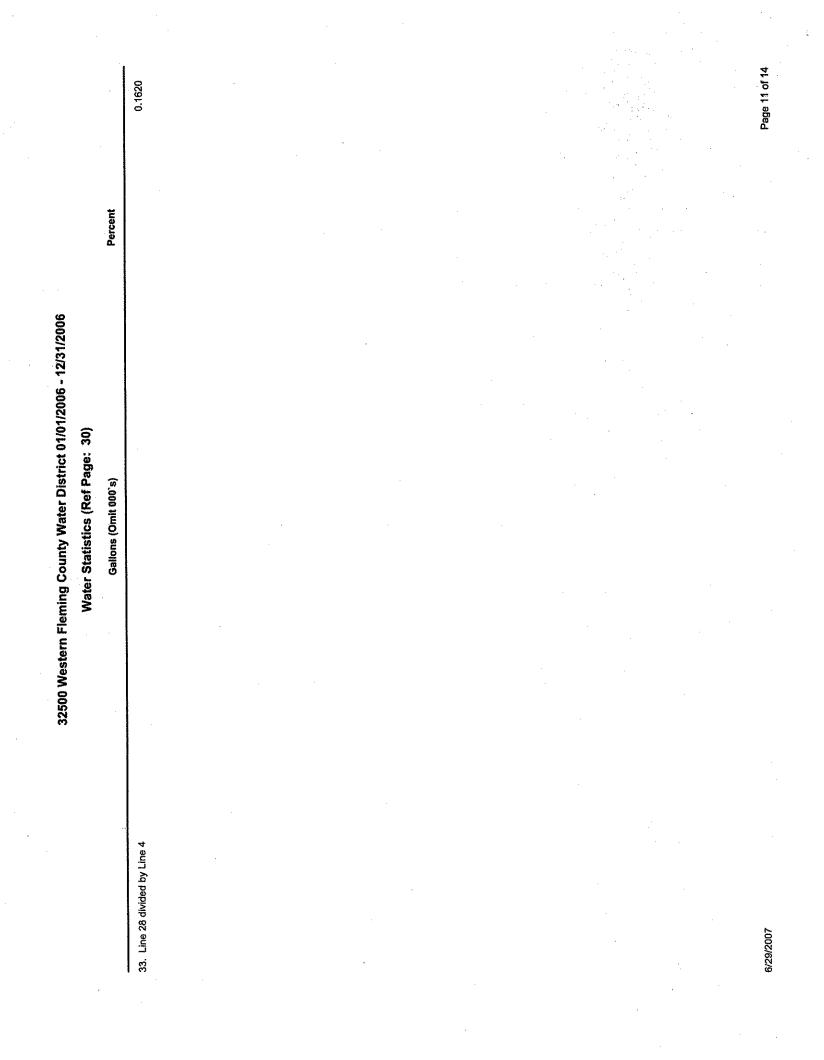

#### **INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT**

To The Board of Commissioners of the Western Fleming County Water District Ewing, Kentucky

I have audited the accompanying financial statements of the business-type activities and each major fund of Western Fleming County Water District as of and for the years ended December 31, 2005 and 2004, which comprise the District's basic financial statements as listed in the table of contents. These financial statements are the responsibility of the management of Western Fleming County Water District. My responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on my audit.

I conducted my audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States.. Those standards require that I plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation. #### 1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accompanying financial statements of the Western Fleming County Water District have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting. Revenue is recognized when earned and expenses are recognized when incurred.

#### (a) Property, Plant and Equipment

Property, plant and equipment purchased are recorded at cost. Depreciation of buildings and equipment is provided on a straight-line basis over the estimated useful lives of the assets. The estimates of useful lives used in computing depreciation are as follows:

(b) <u>Investments</u>

All investments are carried at cost and are required to be collateralized by direct obligations of the United States, FDIC insured, or invested in direct obligations of the United States. Investments consist of certificates of deposits.

#### (c) Income Tax Status

Income of the water district is exempt from tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 115. Accordingly, the financial statements include no provisions for income taxes.

#### (d) <u>Customer Contribution</u>

Following a common industry practice, all tap-on and meter installation fees have been capitalized and recorded as contributed capital

#### (e) Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires the use of management's estimates.

#### (f) Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash equivalents consist of highly liquid investments with an initial maturity of three months or less. Fair value approximates carrying amounts.

The depreciation fund required by the 1988 bond indenture requires that a deposit of \$170 be deposited monthly. As of December 31, 2005, the 1988 depreciation reserve fund had a balance of \$53,967. The 2004 bond indenture requires a bond reserve fund be set-up with the regions bank. This account is set-up and had a balance of \$21,812 as of December 31, 2005.
