MOTION FOR CONFIDENTIALITY

Comes now Jackson Energy Cooperative Corporation, by and through the undersigned counsel, and moves the Commission under the provisions of 807 KAR 5001, Section 7 that Exhibits 1 and 2 to Jackson Energy's application for rate adjustment be kept confidential, and that any further references to salary and wage information of Jackson Energy employees be kept confidential. In support of this motion, Jackson Energy states as follows:

KRS 61.878(1)(a) protects from disclosure and inspection any public records "containing information of a personal nature where the public disclosure thereof would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy."

Furthermore, KRS 61.878(1)(c)(1) provides confidentiality for public records "confidentially disclosed to an agency or required by an agency to be disclosed to it, generally recognized as confidential or proprietary, which if openly disclosed would permit an unfair commercial advantage to competitors of the entity that disclosed the records."

In the above-referenced case, Jackson Energy is required to disclose to the Commission certain information regarding its financial status, which includes the salaries and wages earned by employees of the Cooperative. Specifically this information is

contained in Exhibits 1 and 2 to Jackson Energy's Application for Rate Adjustment. This

information may be contained in other portions of Jackson Energy's Application for Rate

Adjustment and in its Responses to the Commission's Data Requests. In that this

information is of a proprietary and confidential nature, and is likewise of a personal

nature, pursuant to the applicable provisions of KRS 61.878, it should be confidential.

Therefore, Jackson Energy Cooperative moves the Commission to treat as

confidential information regarding employee wages and salaries contained in Exhibits 1

and 2 of its Application for Rate Adjustment and in any other documents which contain

such information. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, a copy of the confidential

material notated but visible is filed, along with ten copies of the material redacted.

Furthermore, a copy of this motion has been served upon the Office of the Attorney

General.
