Proposed adjustment of the wholesale water rates of the Shelbyville
Municipal Water & Sewer

To Whom It May Concern:

The West Shelby Water District respectfully requests that the Public Service Commission allow us to make an adjustment in our rates in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068 Purchased Water Adjustments for Water Districts.

Our supplier, Shelbyville Municipal Water, has informed the District that an increase will take effect September 1, 2007. The District purchased 257,226,000 gallons of water from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 at a total cost of \$429,309.15. The District sold 235,026,600 gallons of water to its customers. With the wholesale increase the new cost is expected to be \$432,966.05. The difference between the old cost and new cost will be \$3,686.90. The incremental cost in terms of water sold is \$0.02 (\$0.0156) cents per 1,000 gallons. We propose to raise each gallonage block that amount.



The Shelbyville Municipal Water & Sewer Commission ("SMW&SC") has filed a proposed rate schedule which will increase the rate for water service as follows:

	Current rate	Proposed Rate	% Increase
North Shelby Water Company	\$1.56 per 1,000 gal.	\$1.61 per 1,000 gal.	3%
West Shelby Water District	\$1.68 per 1,000 gal.	\$1.73 per 1,000 gal.	3%

The proposed effective date is with the September 1, 2007 billing, which will be for water purchased between July 19, 2007 and August 19, 2007, and thereafter, until the next rate change occurs.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the "SMW&SC". However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.



On May 21, 2007, the Shelbyville Municipal Water & Sewer Commission approved and recommended a rate increase (3% on water service, and 4% on sewer service) to the Shelbyville City Council. It is anticipated that the Council will have the first reading/hearing in June and the second reading/hearing by early July.


Upon Council approval, the rate increases shall go into effect with the September 1, 2007 billing, which is for water/sewer usage between mid-July and mid-August.

Dear Mayor Hardesty:

It is the policy of West Shelby Water District to bring the safest and least costly water to our customers.

With your current proposed rate increase to \$1.73 per 1,000 gallons, your wholesale rate to us exceeds any current rate that we are paying to our other supplier. We request, per our 1999 Contract Amendment, to reduce the minimum water usage to 4,000,000 gallons per month, calculated on an annual average basis (calendar year).

We would also like your Commissioners to reconsider this present rate increase and in the future to have West Shelby Water District's wholesale price per 1,000 gallons comparable to Shelbyville Municipal Water and Sewer Commission's lowest rate, as stated in the 1966 Contract. Our wish is to settle this matter in a more cooperative manner; we have therefore, sent notice to the Kentucky Public Service Commission to drop their intervention in your rate increase.

Your future considerations will be most appreciated. I am looking forward to your reply.




