MOTION OF KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY <u>TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE</u>

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"), by counsel, hereby respectfully moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to modify the procedural schedule in this proceeding to allow an additional fourteen days for KU and the other Joint Applicants¹ to file guidelines for the allocation and distribution of the discretionary fund established by the HEA Program ("Guidelines"), which fund sets aside five percent of total HEA funds to be used for arrearage reduction and emergency energy assistance. Issues concerning the draft Guidelines arose late last week and should be resolved within the additional fourteen days requested.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Utilities respectfully moves the Commission to modify the procedural schedule in this proceeding to allow the Joint Applicants an additional fourteen days to file the Guidelines with the Commission, making the Guidelines due to the Commission no later than November 12, 2007.

¹ The Joint Applicants are KU, the Kentucky Association for Community Action, Inc., and the Community Action Council for Lexington-Fayette, Bourbon, Harrison, and Nicholas Counties, Inc.
