Although your additional information regarding my concerns are valid, I am still not convinced of the positive value of the construction of this facility and am still not in favor of this proposed location. However optimum you may think the location is, that is a matter of opinion of you and your client and being a contingous property owner to the proposed location, I feel my direct opinion is a major factor because I am the one who will be viewing and receiving any negative impact from this facility daily, not you nor the owner of this facility.

Being an employee of the state government, particularly a deputy jailer at the Montgomery County Jail System, I work in very close proximity to one of these towers and can tell you first hand of the problems that arise from these particular towers. I am not happy with the proposed facility as first indicated in my original correspondence, and although you have valid points, I am not convinced that this site is optimal for the benefit of my property.
