ORDER

On August 24, 2007, Nolin Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Nolin") filed an application seeking approval of its proposed tariff for a 15,500 initial lumens 150 watt special colonial street light fixture with a 20 foot fluted pole. Nolin proposed that the tariff was to be effective September 22, 2007. Finding that it could not complete its investigation by September 22, 2007, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission suspended the effective date of the proposed tariff for 5 months, up to and including February 21, 2008.

Nolin states that the purpose of its proposed tariff is to provide its customers with an additional choice in lighting. No existing street light tariffs are discontinued as a result of Nolin's proposed tariff and it will be up to the retail consumer if the new light is selected.

Nolin included cost support for its proposed new tariff which provides for the recovery of fixed costs, operation and maintenance costs, administrative costs, and a return on the equity investment.

Finding that good cause exists and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 1. The rate proposed by Nolin and set out in Appendix A to this Order is approved for service rendered on and after the date of this Order.
- 2. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Nolin shall file revised tariffs that set out the rate authorized herein and reflect that it was issued pursuant to this Order.
