We now have an infant and are out even more cost because we will not allow her to consume any of this water; therefore we buy bottled water to substitute. Our sewer already increased this past summer and I feel it is extremely high now I cannot imagine another increase. We just feel this is ridiculous and something needs to be done about the water and the extreme rising costs of the sewer.
