Dear Ms. Stumbo:

On October 24, 2008 Big Rivers and E.ON filed a letter with the Commission proposing a procedural schedule in this case, including a hearing on December 2-3. Alcan Primary Products Corporation and Century Aluminum of Kentucky ("Smelters") support this procedural schedule.

This case has been pending since December 28, 2007. As the Commission is well aware, this Unwind transaction is extremely complex and has already consumed huge amounts of Staff time. But it looks like we may be near the end and that the substantial economic benefits to the economy of Kentucky are close to being realized. These benefits include a dramatic improvement in the financial condition of Big Rivers, rates to the non-Smelter ratepayers that will continue to be among the lowest in the nation and that are likely to be below where they otherwise would be absent the Unwind, and a framework that provides a reasonable opportunity for the Smelters to operate economically. This would help secure 5,000 Smelter and related jobs, an annual payroll of \$193 million, and \$16.7 in annual state and local taxes. Finally, nothing in the Unwind transaction will reduce the Commission's regulatory authority to set fair, just, and reasonable rates consistent with cost of service or other appropriate principles.

Delaying the hearing in this case until: 1) the HMP&L issue is resolved; and 2) Moodys and Standard & Poors have issued credit ratings for Big Rivers would result in an unnecessary delay that could threaten the Unwind. In fact, a finding by the Commission that the Unwind is in the public interest may help resolve the open issues. Instead of delay, consideration by the Commission pursuant to the schedule proposed by Big Rivers and E.ON would be more appropriate.
