STAFF REPORT

SOUTH HOPKINS WATER DISTRICT

Pursuant to a request by South Hopkins Water District ("South Hopkins") for Commission Staff ("Staff") assistance with the preparation of an application for an adjustment of water service rates and non-recurring charges, Staff performed a limited financial review of South Hopkins' test year operations, the calendar year ended December 31, 2006. The scope of Staff's review was limited to obtaining information as to whether the test period operating revenues and expenses were representative of normal operations. Insignificant or immaterial discrepancies were not pursued and are not addressed herein. Upon completion of the review, Staff assisted South Hopkins in the development and preparation of an application to adjust water service rates and non-recurring charges.

On October 24, 2007, South Hopkins filed its application for rate adjustment. In its application, South Hopkins stated a need for additional annual revenues above its current water service rates of \$122,425. Its proposed rates would increase the monthly bill of a customer who uses 5,000 gallons monthly and is served through a 5/8" x 3/4" connection from \$22 to \$25.08, or 14 percent.

South Hopkins also proposes adjustments to the following non-recurring charges:

Tap Fee 5/8" x 3/4"	\$800

Based upon its review of South Hopkins' application, Staff finds that South Hopkins' proposed statement of adjusted test-period operations is reflective of normal operations and should be used to determine South Hopkins' revenue requirement. Staff further finds that South Hopkins' method of determining its revenue requirement is correct and reasonable. Accordingly, Staff is of the opinion that the water service rates and non-recurring charges proposed by South Hopkins, as shown in Attachment A of this report, are reasonable and should be approved by the Commission.

Jason Green is responsible for all revenue adjustments and calculation of the proposed water service rates and non-recurring charges. Scott Lawless is responsible for the determination of the revenue requirement.
