7.2 Standard Residence Local Exchange Service (Continued)

7.2.2 Other Monthly Recurring Charges

**(A) Kentucky Telecommunications Relay Service and
Telecommunications Access Program Surcharge**

Customers subscribing to basic local exchange service will be assessed a monthly surcharge of \$0.04 per access line for the Kentucky Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) and Telecommunications Access Program (TAP).

(B) Kentucky Lifeline Charge

Customers subscribing to basic local exchange service will be assessed a monthly charge of \$0.08 per access line for the Kentucky Lifeline Program.

7.2.3 Usage Sensitive Charges and Allowances

(A) Flat Rate Service

No measured or message charges apply to calls placed or received from Flat Rate service lines. Customers receive unlimited calling within their local calling area.

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
