## ORDER

On October 11, 1993, in Case No. 1993-00111, the Commission approved rates for Belfry Gas Company, Inc. ("Belfry") and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with Belfry's gas cost adjustment ("GCA") clause.'

On November 30, 2007, Belfry filed its GCA to be effective January 1, 2008.
After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Belfry's notice includes revised rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in wholesale gas costs.
2. Belfry's notice sets out an expected gas cost ("EGC") of $\$ 9.2825$ per Mcf, which is an increase of $\$ 1.4614$ per Mcf from its prior EGC of $\$ 7.8211$.
3. Belfry's notice sets out no refund adjustment ("RA"). Belfry's notice sets out no total RA, which is no change from the prior total RA.
4. Belfry's notice sets out a current quarter actual adjustment ("AA") of $\$ .0079$ per Mcf. Belfry used its originally proposed EGC for the months of July, August and September 2007, rather than the corrected EGC that the Commission authorized in
[^0]Case No. 2007-00210. ${ }^{2}$ Correcting for this error produces a current quarter AA of $\$ .0018$ per Mcf. Belfry's total AA is (\$.1285) per Mcf, which is a decrease of $\$ .0091$ from its previous total $A A$.
5. Belfry's notice sets out no balance adjustment.
6. Belfry's GCA is $\$ 9.1540$ per Mcf, which is an increase of $\$ 1.4523$ per Mcf from its previous rate of $\$ 7.7017$.
7. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for billing for service rendered by Belfry on and after January 1, 2008.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Belfry are denied.
2. The rates in the Appendix, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are approved for billing for service rendered on and after January 1, 2008.
3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Belfry shall file with the Commission its revised tariff sheets setting out the rates authorized herein.
