Motion for Procedural Schedule


Kentucky Power Company moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky pursuant to the Commission's January 23, 2008 Order for an Order establishing a procedural schedule in this matter. In support thereof, Kentucky Power states:

1. In its January 23, 2008 Order, the Commission directed any party wishing to file testimony to petition the Commission for an Order establishing a procedural schedule.
2. Kentucky Power proposes to file the testimony of Errol K. Wagner in this proceeding. Mr. Wagner's testimony is designed to address the recent Order of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission directing PJM to change its methodology for determining and allocating to load serving entities such as Kentucky Power the costs associated with transmission line losses and the change's effect on the method for calculating Kentucky Power's fuel costs for purposes of the fuel adjustment charge.
3. Kentucky Power is prepared to file its testimony on or before February 6, 2008.

4. Establishing the resulting procedural schedule should not delay these proceedings or require that the scheduled March 18, 2008 hearing be postponed.

Wherefore, Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests that a procedural established in connection with the planned filing of the testimony of Errol K. Wagner.


