Dear Mayor Embry:

On April 7, 2008 the Grayson County Water District made application to the Kentucky Public Service Commission for an increase in water rates of seven percent (7%). After the Commission staff reviewed the application it was found that an increase of 7% was allowable but if the District so chose we could request an increase of as much as 10.3%.

At the Water Board meeting on August 18, 2008 it was discussed as to which rate to choose, and due the dynamics of the changing economy in the past few months it was the decision of the Water District to request the higher amount as the prudent rate to use. Please be advised that the District has resubmitted to the Kentucky Public Service Commission for increases in rates, both for its retail and wholesale customers of ten point three percent (10.3 %).

You will find in the enclosed attachments the proposed new rates as well as the Water District's response to the Kentucky Public Service Commission.

Upon approval by the Commission the wholesale rates charged to the City of Caneyville will change from the current \$1.81 per 1,000 gallons used to \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons used.
