This is an application to review language and certain non-recurring charges for the Letcher County Water & Sewer District. Attached is the non-recurring charge cost justifications and the proposed new tariff.

Letcher County Water & Sewer District is not requesting a water rate increase at this time. However, increased costs attributable to certain non-recurring charges can no longer be absorbed by the District. The customers affected by these increases will be the customers that cause the District to incur these additional expenses.

The District has previously filed income statements and balance sheets with the Public Service Commission. These income statements and balance sheets are currently on file with the Commission.

The District will publish the enclosed public notice of these requested rate revisions in the local newspaper for three consecutive weeks. The first notice has already been published and the newspaper ad is enclosed. We will follow up with a filing of the second and third newspaper ads along with an affidavit from the newspaper verifying that the notice was published for three consecutive weeks.

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SOLICITATION OF PUBLIC COMMENT

The Kentucky Division of Abandoned Mine Lands (KYDAML) is soliciting public comment on a proposed Abandoned Mine Land Enhancement Rule Reclamation Project in the community of McRoberts on Shea Fork. The project is being proposed pursuant to the guidelines in 30 CFR 874.17, and the Commonwealth of Kentucky's Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Plan. The Division will accept comments from the public until close-of-business August 15, 2008. Any person or group may submit comments in writing through the United States Postal Service or via email.

The project involves a proposed cooperative reclamation effort between the Kentucky Department for Natural Resources (DNR) and a contractor to remove coal refuse from an abandoned coal refuse dump located on the north side of Shea Fork. The refuse was deposited by the Consolidation Coal Co. Mine #210. The project proposes to remove the refuse via a haulroad constructed from Hwy 343 approximately 300 hundred feet north of the McRoberts post office along and above the Elkhorn #3 coal seam to the refuse pile. The refuse will be trucked from the site along the haulroad then to the Premier Elkhorn Coal Co. permitted preparation plant in Myra, KY. After refuse removal is completed the former dump area will be regraded and vegetated in a manner described in the project narrative.
