



Due to a rate increase from Northern Kentucky Water District, notice is hereby given that Pendleton County Water District has filed An Application for a Purchased Water Adjustment with the Kentucky Public Service Commission for the purpose of adjusting its water rates. Customer rates will increase by .30 cents per 1,000 gallons used. The proposed change will be effective for water used on and after March 15, 2008.
