Transvlvania University is offering junior high and high school students three summer academic camps in the areas of computer languages and programs as well as robotics.

Introduction to Computer Programming studentsenteringgrades 8-12—As participants in this program, students will learn about computer fundamentals and computer languages. In addition, students will learn the basics of Web design and have the opportunity to study other academic areas such as music, chemistry and philosophy.

The camp is offered June 22-27. The cost is \$300 per camper and is limited to 40 students. The application deadline is May 1.

Advanced Lego Robotics or Linux System Administration - students entering grades 10-12—The purpose of this camp is to give you a deeper, more intense introduction to the world of Lego Robotics or the Linux Operating System.

The camp is offered June 15-20. The cost is \$350 per camper and is limited to 35 students. In order to be eligible for this camp, you must have attended a previous Transylvania computer camp, or taken some high school programming classes. The application deadline is May 1.

Day Camp for Programming and Robotics - students entering grades 6-8-As participants in this program, students will gain an introduction to the fundamentals of robot building and programming or learn to program in BASIC or C++.

The camp is offered June 30-July 3, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily. The cost is \$175 per camper plus an optional extra charge for the robotics camp, and this program is limited to 35 students. The application deadline is May 1.
