Dear Ms. Stumbo:

Please find enclosed the Association's request for a purchased water rate adjustment. This adjustment request is due to several factors as will be discussed in the following:

- (1) An increased cost of wholesale water from the City of Lancaster that will be effective on April 1, 2008. Exhibit "A" is attached to the application showing this agreed to rate increase.
- (2) An increased cost of wholesale water from the City of Berea became effective in the past. This increase was not communicated to the Association and as a result was not passed on to the Association's customer base. Due to the nature of purchases from the City of Berea this increase was not discovered until the Association's independent audit was conducted in January 2008. The Association does not desire to recover any fees from the City of Berea at this time, even though they did not communicate this increase to the Association. Due to the fact that there is no formal notice from the City of Berea, enclosed is the most recent statement from the City of Berea to the Association detailing water charges and additional fees. This is labeled Exhibit B. Also attached is a copy of the rate schedule the Association was utilizing as specified in the original contract between the City of Berea and the Association. This is labeled as Exhibit C.
- (3) An increased cost of wholesale water from the City of Danville became effective in the past. This increase was not communicated to the Association and as a result was not passed on to the Association's customer base. Due to the nature of purchases from the City of Danville this increase was not discovered until the Association's independent audit was conducted in January 2008. The Association does not desire to recover any fees from the City of Danville at this time, even though they did not communicate this

increase to the Association. Due to the fact that there is no formal notice from the City of Danville, enclosed is the most recent statement from the City of Danville to the Association detailing water charges and additional fees. This is labeled Exhibit D. Also attached is a copy of the rate schedule the Association was utilizing as specified in the original contract between the City of Danville and the Association. This is labeled as Exhibit E.

Also, enclosed is a revised tariff sheet reflecting the ten cent per thousand gallons adjustment.

The Association will notify its customers of the rate adjustment before rendering the first customer statement reflecting the increase.



A meter registering not more than 2% above or below the test result shall be deemed to be accurate. The previous readings of any meter disclosed by tests to be inaccurate shall be corrected for the six (6) months previous to such tests in accordance with the percentage of inaccuracy found by such tests. If any meter fails to register for any period, the amount of water delivered in the corresponding period immediately prior to the failure shall be considered the amount consumed, unless the Seller

and Purchaser shall agree upon a different amount. The metering equipment shall be read on a regular basis, but not less than once every month. An appropriate official or representative of the Purchaser shall at all reasonable times have access to the meter for the purpose of verifying its readings.

5. The Purchaser agrees to pay to Seller for water delivered in accordance with the following rate schedule based on monthly consumption:

6. In addition to the foregoing schedule of rates, the Purchaser shall further pay to Seller a surcharge of twenty percent (20%) to be added to the total water bill (not including any applicable taxes or fees).

HOWEVER, the parties understand and agree that if at any time during the term of this agreement the rate charged to other wholesale consumers, including other municipalities, independent water districts, or privately owned water companies, are modified, either increased or decreased, the rate of charge to the Purchaser shall automatically be modified to confirm to such rates; similarly, it is agreed and understood that in the event the amount of the surcharge which is charged to all wholesale customers outside the city limits of Seller, is modified, then the rate of surcharge unto Purchaser shall automatically be modified to conform with such surcharge rate. It is understood and agreed by the parties that modification of the water purchase rate and the surcharge thereon shall be at the discretion of the Seller, City of Danville. The City of Danville shall be required to give a written five (5) month advance notice of any rate increase and comply with any applicable Public Service Commission rulings.

7. The Purchaser shall not consume more than the monthly limit without written permission from the Seller except in the case
