Enclosed for filing are an original and four (4) conformed copies of Duke Energy Kentucky's ("Duke") "Monthly Report of Gas Cost Calculations and Tariff Schedules," for the month commencing with the May 2008 revenue month in accordance with KPSC order dated November 6, 2003 in Case No. 2003-00386. This filing is based on supplier tariff rates expected to be in effect on April 30, 2008 and the NYMEX on April 8, 2008 for the month of May 2008.

The above described schedules and GCA are effective with the final meter readings of District 1, May 2008, revenue month (i.e., final meter readings on and after April 30, 2008).

Duke's proposed GCA is \$11.530 per Mcf. This rate represents a decrease of \$0.378 per Mcf from the rate currently in effect for April 2008.

RATE RS RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to firm natural gas service, which is comprised of commodity gas supply and local delivery service, required for all domestic purposes in private residences, single occupancy apartments, and common use areas of multi-occupancy buildings, when supplied at one point of delivery where distribution mains are adjacent to the premises to be served.

NET MONTHLY BILL

The Net Monthly Bill is determined as follows: All gas is billed in units of 100 cubic feet (CCF).

Plus, all delivered gas shall be subject to an adjustment per CCF as set forth on Sheet No. 62, Rider DSMR, Demand Side Management Rate.

Plus, all gas delivered shall be subject to an adjustment per CCF as set forth on Sheet No. 64, Rider MSR-G, Merger Savings Credit Rider-Gas.

The "Customer Charge" shown above plus Rider AMRP shall be the minimum amount billed each month.

GENERAL SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to firm natural gas service, which is comprised of commodity gas supply and local delivery service, required for any purpose by an individual non-residential customer at one location when supplied at one point of delivery where distribution mains are adjacent to the premises to be served. This schedule is also applicable to non-metered natural gas commodity supplies and local delivery service for street lighting to such entities as certificated homeowners associations, businesses, and federal, state, and local governments. The Company may decline requests for service under this tariff due to gas supply limitations.
