**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF

Pursuant to K.R.S. §278.310 and 807 KAR 5:001 Section 3(8), Bluegrass Generation Company, L.L.C. ("Bluegrass") requests that it be granted full intervenor status in the above-captioned proceeding and states in support thereof as follows:

1. Bluegrass operates a natural gas-fired peaking generation facility located in Oldham County, Kentucky, which is interconnected with the transmission system of Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E"). Bluegrass is a subsidiary of Dynegy Inc. ("Dynegy"). Through its subsidiaries, Dynegy produces and sells energy, capacity and ancillary services in key U.S. markets. The power generation portfolio consists of more than 19,000 megawatts of baseload, intermediate and peaking power plants fueled by a mix of natural gas, coal and fuel oil.


