Comes now the Garrard County Water Association, Inc. ("Garrard Water") for its response to the Order of the Commission entered in the within case on September 25, 2009, would state as follows:

That all evidence presented in the case demonstrates that the City of Danville increased the water rates charged to Garrard Water (as well as the other parties) without seeking approval for these rate increases through the PSC. It has also been further demonstrated that the City of Danville did not knowingly increase these rates to Garrard Water. The rate increases appear to be the result of clerical mistakes within the operations of the City of Danville.

After discussions with the City of Danville a settlement agreement was reached that resulted in a repayment plan to Garrard Water of the agreed upon over charges. This settlement agreement made no provision for payment of a penalty. Garrard Water is not seeking the imposition of penalties upon the City of Danville. This decision lies within the sound discretion of the Commission.
