
The Commission acknowledges receipt of Madison County Utility District's response on June 26, 2008. However, Madison County Utility District's application is rejected pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 2, for the reasons set forth below. These items are either required to be filed with the application or to be referenced in the application if they are already on file in another case.

1. Filing deficiencies pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(7)(c):
  5. Complete description of actual plant retirements and anticipated plant retirements related to the pro forma plant additions including the actual or anticipated date of retirement;
  6. Original cost, cost of removal and salvage for each component of plant to be retired during the period of the proposed pro forma adjustment for plant additions;

7. Explanation of any differences in amounts contained in the capital construction budget and amounts of capital construction cost contained in the pro forma adjustment period; and
  8. Impact on depreciation expense of all proposed pro forma adjustments for plant additions and retirements.
2. Filing deficiencies pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(6)(g):  
Analysis of customers' bills in such detail that revenues from present and proposed rates can be readily determined for each customer class.
  3. Filing deficiencies pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6(1) through Section 6(9):  
All information should cover the period ending not more than 90 days prior to date of which application was filed.

The statutory time period in which the Commission must process this case will not commence until the above-mentioned information is filed with the Commission. If Madison County Utility District's filing contains a proposed effective date, the rejection of this filing for reasons of deficiency voids that proposed effective date. When you file the required information to correct the deficiencies, you may re-file your proposed tariff with a new proposed effective date that is at least 30 days from the date you file the required information. You are requested to file an original and ten copies of this information within 10 days of the date of this letter.
