1. Filing deficiencies pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001:

807 KAR 5:001: Section 9(2)(b)Copies of franchises or permits, if any, from the proper public authority for the proposed new construction or extension, if not previously filed with the Commission.


807 KAR 5:001: Section 9(2)(c)A full description of the proposed location, route, or routes of the new construction or extension, including a description of the manner in which same will be constructed, and also the names of all public utilities, corporations, or persons with whom the proposed new construction or extension is likely to compete.

807 KAR 5:001: Section 9(2)(f)An estimated cost of operation after the proposed facilities are completed.

The statutory time period in which the Commission must process this case will not commence until the above-mentioned information is filed with the Commission. When you file the required information to correct the deficiencies, you may refile your proposed tariff with a new proposed effective date that is at least 30 days from the date you file the required information. 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
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
