O R D E R

This matter arises upon the joint motion of Community Action Kentucky, Inc. and Community Action Council for Lexington-Fayette, Bourbon, Harrison and Nicholas Counties, Inc. (collectively "CAK/CAC") filed August 12, 2008 for full intervention. It appearing to the Commission that CAK/CAC have a common interest in low-income utility customers, they are represented by the same counsel, and their joint intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings, and this Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. CAK/CAC are granted joint intervention.
2. CAK/CAC shall be jointly entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.


