Please accept this letter from Cellere, as agent for Central States Tower and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, as the formal response to anonymous letter regarding unauthorized practice of law and request for approval of application for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

In response to the anonymous letter submitted to the Commission stating that entities submitting applications to the Kentucky Public Service Commission must be represented by a licensed attorney, we respectfully submit the following evidence

Per the PSC Regulations 807 KAR 5:001 Rules of Procedure. Section 3 (4):


(4) Signing of pleadings. Every pleading of a party represented by an attorney shall be signed by at least one (1) attorney of record in his individual name and shall state his address. Except when otherwise specifically provided by statute, pleadings need not be verified or accompanied by affidavit

The applicant is only required to have an attorney sign the application, if they are being represented by an attorney.

As we have met the requirements for the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, we are asking that the Commission issue the CPCN or provide us with an update as to the status of our application.
