Dear Mr. Huffman;

Thank you for your letter and concerns noted regarding the proposed telecommunications tower near your property. As per your questions regarding the access road, it will not be located on, near or include any portion of your property. The construction will take approximate 45 days to complete and will be performed in a manner to reduce or eliminate any environmental impact to the parcel. Once the site is complete there will be no adverse or environmental impact to the parcel or surrounding parcels.

Furthermore, wireless communications facilities are regulated and monitored by the federal government and pursuant to the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, all wireless carrier must be licensed and operate within the guidelines of the assigned frequency. The information studied to this point by the federal government and related agencies has shown no adverse health effects that would allow a community to approve or deny the location of such facility.
