Water loss was estimated to be 12-13%, all totals were not in at the time of the meeting due to the meeting falling on the 1st.

Vernon Barton and Billy Hunter from Western-Fleming County Water District were present to discuss a rate increase. Currently, the wholesale rates are \$1.13 per 1,000 gallons. With the rate increase, the rate will be \$1.43 per 1,000 gallons. The rate increase is to offset expenses to improve and increase holding capacity at the treatment plant.
