

Please refer to (assigned docket number) in your correspondence."
- (2) Section 1(2)(b) – The notice posted on the nearest public road must state: "(Name of utility) proposes to construct a telecommunications ('tower' or 'monopole') on this site. If you have questions, please contact (name and address of utility) or Executive Director, Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, PO Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602. Please refer to (assigned docket number) in your correspondence."
- (3) Section 1(2)(c) – In both posted notices, the word "tower" or "monopole" shall be printed in letters at least four (4) inches high.

The statutory time period in which the Commission must process this case will not commence until the above-mentioned information is filed with the Commission. If your filing contains a proposed effective date, the rejection of your filing for reasons of deficiencies voids the proposed effective date. When you file the required information to correct the deficiencies you may refile your proposed tariff with

a new proposed effective date that is at least 30 days from the date you file the required information. You are requested to file 10 copies of this information within 15 days of date of this letter.
