ORDER

On August 5, 2008, Muhlenberg County Water District ("Muhlenberg") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Muhlenberg purchases water from the city of Central City ("Central City").
2. Central City notified Muhlenberg that, effective September 1, 2008, the wholesale rate would increase from \$1.2558 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.57 per 1,000 gallons.
3. Muhlenberg proposes a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.40 per 1,000 gallons.
4. During the 12-month period ending June 30, 2008, Muhlenberg purchased 515,854,500 gallons of water. It sold 409,359,500 gallons of water during the same period.

5. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$162,081.48, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.40 per 1,000 gallons.

6. Muhlenberg proposed to increase the rates to its customers effective September 1, 2008.

7. On August 21, 2008, Central City, pursuant to KRS 278.180 and 807 KAR 5:011, notified the Commission of its intent to increase its wholesale water rate on September 20, 2008. The Commission having taken no action to suspend the proposed adjustment, the proposed wholesale rate became effective September 20, 2008

8. KRS 278.015 permits a water district to increase its rates commensurate with an increase from its wholesale supplier, but not prior to the effective date of the wholesale supplier's increase.

9. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.40 per 1,000 gallons is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Muhlenberg are approved.

2. The September 1, 2008 effective date proposed by Muhlenberg is denied.

3. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.40 per 1,000 gallons as calculated in Appendix A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is approved.


4. The rates in Appendix B, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved for service provided on or after September 20, 2008.

5. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Muhlenberg shall file with the Commission revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
