Dear Ms. Yates:

Commission Staff received your letter and Proposed Settlement Agreement on October 16, 2009. As was discussed at the informal conferences on May 13, 2009 and September 23, 2009, Commission Staff is unable to reach a consensus on our recommendation to the Commission regarding this case. Staff, therefore, cannot sign the Proposed Settlement Agreement.

Nevertheless, we do not discourage Purchase Public Service Corporation ("PPSC") from recommending to the Commission that the conditions identified in the Proposed Settlement Agreement should be accepted as a resolution of this case. If PPSC wishes to pursue this course of action, please file a letter stating that the utility would like to propose that the conditions of the Proposed Settlement Agreement be accepted by the Commission as a resolution for this case despite Commission Staff's unwillingness to sign the agreement. If PPSC chooses not to submit its proposed resolution for consideration by the Commission, please contact me to set up an informal conference so that we discuss other options available to the utility.
