ORDER

On August 28, 2008, Thomas Country Estates applied for Commission approval of its proposed sewer rates. Thomas Country Estates proposed to increase its annual revenue from sewer rates by \$9,107, an increase of 27.6 percent over normalized sewer revenues of \$33,000. This proposal would increase the monthly sewer bill from \$27.50 to \$35.09, an increase of 27.6 percent.

By Order dated October 9, 2008, the Commission issued a Staff Report containing Commission Staff's findings and recommendations regarding the proposed rate adjustment. In its report, Staff recommended that Thomas Country Estates' proposed rates be accepted. In its Order, the Commission directed all parties to file any written comments regarding the Staff Report or requests for a hearing or informal conference within 10 days. If no request for hearing was received within that period, the Commission further ordered that the case would stand submitted for decision. No comments or requests for a hearing or informal conference have been received.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. The recommendations and findings contained in the Staff Report are supported by the evidence of record, are reasonable, and should be adopted as the findings of the Commission.

2. The monthly sewer rates in Appendix A will produce annual revenue from sewer service of \$42,107.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The findings contained in the Staff Report are adopted and incorporated by reference into this Order as if fully set out herein.

2. The rates in Appendix A are approved for service rendered by Thomas Country Estates on and after the date of this Order.

3. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Thomas Country Estates shall file with the Commission revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein.
