
PUBLIC NOTICE

PURCHASED WATER ADJUSTMENT

Due to an increase in the wholesale rate for water purchased from the Frankfort Plant Board, the South Anderson Water District has applied to the Kentucky Public Service Commission for a rate increase to cover its increased costs. The rates contained herein are the rates proposed by South Anderson Water District, however the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that are higher or lower than the rates proposed in this notice. Any corporation, association, body public or person may request leave to intervene by motion within thirty (30) days after notice of the proposed rates change is given. A motion to intervene shall be in writing, shall be submitted to the Executive Director, Kentucky Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, P. O. Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602, and shall set forth the grounds for the motion including the status and interest of the party. Copies of the application may be obtained at no charge from the South Anderson Water District at 142 South Main St., Lawrenceburg, KY 40342.

The proposed rates are scheduled to go into effect with the first billing following January 1, 2009. The proposed rate increase will only recover the District's increase in the cost of purchased water.
