NOTICE

Please take notice that Duke Energy Kentucky (DE-Kentucky) will be applying to the Kentucky Public Service Commission for approval to revise its Demand Side Management (DSM) rate for electric service and gas service for residential and commercial customers. DE-Kentucky's current monthly DSM rate for residential gas customers is \$(0.0109294) cents per hundred cubic feet and for non-residential gas customers is \$0.0000 cents per hundred cubic feet. DE-Kentucky's current monthly DSM rate for residential electric customers is \$0.001416 cents per kilowatt-hour and for non-residential customers is \$0.001405 cents per kilowatt-hour for distribution service and \$0.000154 per kilowatt-hour for transmission service.

DE-Kentucky seeks approval to revise these rates as follows: DE-Kentucky's monthly DSM rate for residential gas customers would increase to \$0.066904 cents per hundred cubic feet and for non-residential gas customers would remain at \$0.0000 cents per hundred cubic feet. DE-Kentucky's monthly DSM rate for residential electric customers would increase to \$0.002036 cents per kilowatt-hour and for non-residential customers would decrease to \$0.000512 cents per kilowatt-hour for distribution service and would decrease to \$0.000047

The rate contained in this notice is the rate proposed by DE-Kentucky. However, the Public Service Commission may order a rate to be charged that differs from this proposed rate. Such action may result in a rate for consumers other than the rate in this notice. The foregoing rates reflect a proposed increase in electric revenues of approximately \$0.1 million or 0.04% over current total electric revenues and an increase of \$7.2 million or 4.9% over current gas revenues.
