SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered this ____ day of March, 2009, by and between the STAFF OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF KENTUCKY ("Commission Staff") and Ledbetter Water District ("Ledbetter District") and William P. Dae, Chairman; Terry Teitloff, Vice-Chairman; and Arnie Puckett, Commissioner, and Bill Gillahan, Commissioner, individually and as officers of the utility.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Ledbetter District is a Chapter 74 non-profit water district utility subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission, pursuant to KRS 278.010; and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2009, the Public Service Commission entered an order establishing this case and directing Ledbetter District and William P. Dae, Chairman; Terry Teitloff, Vice-Chairman; and Arnie Puckett, Commissioner, and Bill Gillahan, Commissioner, individually and as officers of the utility, to show cause why

each of them should not be subject to penalties for violation of KRS 278.015 and 278.160; and

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2009, Ledbetter District and William P. Dae, Chairman; Terry Teitloff, Vice-Chairman; and Arnie Puckett, Commissioner, and Bill Gillahan, Commissioner, individually and as officers of the utility, by counsel, filed a response to the Commission's Order; and

WHEREAS, Ledbetter District and William P. Dae, Chairman; Terry Teitloff, Vice-Chairman; Arnie Puckett, Commissioner, and Bill Gillahan, Commissioner, individually and as officers of the utility, by counsel; and Commission Staff held an informal conference on March 4, 2009 to discuss all issues and any possible settlement of all matters; and

WHEREAS, Ledbetter District and William P. Dae, Chairman; Terry Teitloff, Vice-Chairman; Arnie Puckett, Commissioner, and Bill Gillahan, Commissioner, individually and as officers of the utility; and Commission Staff desire to settle the issues raised by this proceeding and have entered into this Settlement Agreement through compromise to settle this proceeding,

NOW, THEREFORE, Ledbetter District and William P. Dae, Chairman; Terry Teitloff, Vice-Chairman; Arnie Puckett, Commissioner, and Bill Gillahan, Commissioner, individually and as officers of the utility by counsel; and Commission Staff agree that:

1. Ledbetter District and William P. Dae, Chairman; Terry Teitloff, Vice-Chairman; and Arnie Puckett, Commissioner, and Bill Gillahan, Commissioner, individually and as officers of the utility, waive a formal hearing before the Commission.

2. Ledbetter District shall be assessed a civil penalty of \$2,500 for a violation of KRS 278015(2) by failure to obtain Commission approval of its revised tariff showing the increase in the rate charged by its wholesale supplier. However, the civil penalty shall be probated for a period of two years conditioned upon no violations of KRS Chapter 278 or Commission regulations.

3. William P. Dae, Chairman; Terry Teitloff, Vice-Chairman; and Arnie Puckett, Commissioner, and Bill Gillahan, Commissioner, individually and as officers of the utility shall be assessed a civil penalty each of \$2,500 for a violation of KRS 278.015(2) for failure to obtain Commission approval of Ledbetter District's revised tariff showing the increase in the rate charged by its wholesale supplier. However, the civil penalty shall be probated for a period of two years conditioned upon each Water Commissioner attending two annual water district management training programs as provided by the Kentucky Public Service Commission. After completion of said annual training, the probated civil penalty shall be forgiven.

3. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as an admission of a willful violation of any statute or administrative regulation by Ledbetter District and William P. Dae, Chairman; Terry Teitloff, Vice-Chairman; and Arnie Puckett, Commissioner, and Bill Gillahan, Commissioner, individually and as officers of the utility; nor shall the Public Service Commission's acceptance of this agreement be construed as a finding of a willful violation of any statute or administrative regulation.

6. This Agreement is subject to the acceptance of and approval by the Public Service Commission.

7. If the Public Service Commission fails to accept and approve this Settlement Agreement in its entirety, this proceeding shall go forward and neither the terms of this Settlement Agreement nor any matters raised during settlement negotiations shall be binding on any signatory or be construed against either Ledbetter District, the Water Commissioners, or Commission Staff.

8. Commission Staff shall recommend to the Public Service Commission that this Settlement Agreement be accepted and approved.
