ORDER

On March 11, 2009, the Commission entered an Order requiring Cannonsburg Water District ("Cannonsburg"), among other things, to adjust or credit affected customer accounts. Cannonsburg was directed to verify to the Commission that all such customer accounts had been credited or adjusted for any amounts in excess of the effective rate.¹ On March 23, 2009, the Commission received a letter from Cannonsburg requesting additional time in which to comply with the verification requirement. We will consider the letter as a motion to modify the Order of March 11, 2009 for an extension of time for Cannonsburg to file its verification.

Cannonsburg states that its software program is unsuited to perform the task and that each customer's account for the January and February 2009 billings will have to be individually adjusted by a member of Canonsburg's staff. Cannonsburg says this may involve 3,500 customers. Cannonsburg is requesting 60 days, rather than the 30 days given, in which to perform the verification and report to the Commission.


The Commission finds that Cannonsburg has presented sufficient grounds for a modification of the Order of March 11, 2009 to extend the time in which to file its verification.

The Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The motion to extend the reporting time is granted.

2. Ordering Paragraph 5 of the Order of March 11, 2009 is modified to extend from 30 days to 60 days the time for Cannonsburg to verify in writing its action on the customer accounts.
